Customers are responsible for monitoring lawn and ornamental plants between regularly scheduled visits. If problems develop, notify us promptly so we can schedule a no charge courtesy call. Since many factors outside the company's control can affect the condition of lawns and ornamental plants (including but not limited to mowing practices, irrigation, adverse weather and soil problems) we cannot be responsible for sod or ornamental replacement.

Dethatching: *St. Augustine* (Pursley Seville, Horatam, Bitter Blue) – These grasses build up thatch quickly. Thatch restricts movement of water, air fertilizers and pesticides into the soil. This increases the chances for diseases and decline. For established lawns we recommend vertical cutting in the spring prior to growing season, every two to three years. Vertical machines have vertical blades that slice though the turf and pull the thatch to the surface for removal.

Watering: Always allow for the watering in of pesticides when necessary. *St. Augustine* (Pursley Seville, Floratam, Bitter Blue) – Water in the morning (between 4:00am to 9:00am) one inch of water per application. Watering may be reduced during cooler months and periods of rainfall. *Bahia* – This is the best drought tolerant grass available. However, lack of water will turn it brown. For a consistent green color, we recommend morning watering (between 4:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m.) during dry periods. Water should be applied in the morning hours to allow the grass to dry lessening the chance for disease. Bahia lawns may require watering in the evening prior to a mole treatment for best results.

Mowing: All grasses should be cut at a height of or at least 3 inches. Always use a sharpened blade. We recommend having 2 blades and changing them every mowing. Remember never cut more than one third of the grass height. Lawn mower blade height should be set on a concrete surface.
