- DO NOT USE ANY TREESTAND IF YOU HAVE NOT FOL-LOWED THE MANUFACTURERS CARE AND MAINTE-NANCE GUIDELINES!

Preparing for Installation

The Viper Blind Treestand Accessory is designed to be used with the Viper, Viper XTreme, Viper XL or Viper XTreme XL

Climbing Treestands. NOTE: If using a treestand with a foot rest attached, the foot rest must be in the retracted or down position before using the Viper Blind. It may be used with other stand-up, sit-down climbing treestands; however, you must check with the particular treestand manufacturer to ensure that the addition of the Viper Blind presents no additional safety hazards by its use.

Using the Viper Blind

NOTE: DO NOT attempt to climb with your Viper Blind on the tree-stand!

After you have reached your hunting height and have secured your seat and safety belt (you MUST climb with your safety belt attached!), pull the Viper Blind up by your bow or gun rope, as shown in Figure 1. The top of the Viper Blind is the section with the elastic shock cord encased in the camoutlage material and bunched up on the shock cord. Take the two S-hooks (one in each hand) while (acing the tree, as shown in Figure 2. CAUTION: DO NOT position the seat and platform such that the Viper Blind exerts upward pressure on the bottom of the treestand platform. Pull the bottom of the Viper Blind toward the tree using a sawing motion (pull one side towards the tree then pull the other side towards the tree) until the bottom of the Viper Blind touches the tree, as shown in Figure 3. For best results, position the bottom of the Viper Blind over each end of the grip strips (the scalloped edge v-bar that comes in contact with the tree) as shown in Figure 4. Now pull the Viper Blind up until the bottom of it is touching the bottom of your treestand platform. Finally, pull the clastic shock cord with the S-hooks up and over the cables on the top (seat) portion of your treestand (see Figure 5) and secure the S-hooks as shown in Figure 6. Your Viper Blind is now ready for use. If desired, the small pockets on each side (inside) the Viper Blind may be used to store air-activated hand warmers, which will help heat

ready for use. If desired, the small pockets on each side (inside) the Viper Blind may be used to store air-activated hand warmers, which will help heat the inside of the Viper Blind. They are small pockets and are not intended for placing your hands or holding any hunting accessories.

Removing the Viper Blind

To remove the Viper Blind, simply unbook the S-hooks that you secured in Figure 6. Now slowly and carefully begin to slide the Viper Blind away from the tree until it is completely free from the treestand platform (bottom)

and seat (top). Secure it to your gun or bow rope and let it down to the ground.

Care and Maintenance of The Viper Blind

If the Viper Blind is allowed to get wet, make sure it is completely dry before storing it. The addition of a moisture preventive may help eliminate moisture problems.
