Et message from the founder

Fellow Hunters:

Before reviewing this catalog, I hope you will join us in supporting our military for the job they're doing to protect our liberty. Our freedom continues to have a high cost.

With satisfied customers and good products, it's increasingly difficult for us to find improvements but we continue to do so.

Once again we've made improvements and added additional products that benefit hunters. The multitude of compliments we receive from Summit users about how our features contributed to their hunting success has certainly placed our staff as being foremost in treestand design and engineering. Good design requires the experience of long-time hunters and a formal education isn't the only basis of good engineering; manufacturing technology and cost-value analysis to compete with today's low cost foreign labor are also very important. Summit has it all, so we will continue to set the benchmark for treestands in both 'huntability' and safety.

Here are some improvements we've made. 1) Folding footrests will be furnished on the new "X4" climbing stand platforms. 2) The 'uprights' (angled sides) that the cable goes into are curved for enhanced comfort and to eliminate a minor rattling noise only when moving. 3) The 'hatch cover' that eliminates the cable from possibly retracting is replaced with an automatic cable retention spring. 4) Platform foot-straps and heel cords are replaced with a foot bar on the curved upright to allow twisting your foot to lock the platform for easy climbing control. 5) An improved Bushmaster seat. 6) An improved full body harness. (Incidentally, beginning this year all TMA Certified treestands require that a full body harness be furnished. It's our 5th year to furnish the FBH).

New models are also available. 1) The Cobra X4 which is an open front design but allows standup/sit-down climbing. 2) The HeadHunter X4 and Copperhead X4 which feature quick and quiet free attachment, are light weight at 11 pounds, and also sport newly designed comfortable folding seats. (It's doubtful that there are any other hang-on that are as simple and easy to hang). 3) The ClearShot, a climber that has a folding seat attached to the platform (it weighs 15 pounds and the optional hand-climber just 2 pounds). 4) An aluminum ladder stand (12' or 18') that requires no 'props' in that it is self-supporting, easy to assemble and erect, and has stay-in-your-seat comfort.

After field-testing these improvements and new models and reflecting back on the past, I'm grateful to all those I've hunted with. We also appreciate those who assisted us with suggestions and especially our employees here at Summit. Our folks are dedicated to quality products at competitive prices but just as important they all understand

and focus on what our stands have been bringing to hunters each year: **Security, Comfort, Camouflage and Silence**. Being part of the Pradco/Ebsco team has allowed Summit the freedom for even further growth. Our Pak-Mule and food plot equipment are examples. These successful products are hunter related and they provide benefits to hunters just like our treestands, i.e., they fit our mission.

Making fun of my Dad was a no-no to me, but I failed to pass that on to my own sons. They put me in a white lab coat and refer to me as "lab coat guy" as you may have noticed in some TV commercials. The ads are entertaining and informative but I feel pretty silly. They're finally out-hunting me too, bringing in 10 pointers, elk, videoing friends taking 360 plus bulls, bowhunting African game... even my oldest grandson scored on an elk and a whitetail bowhunting. My 2nd grandson took his first doe *and* his first buck this season too. However, I consider it a blessing and I'm assured that they and everyone who hunts with us wears their safety harness.

Please do a thorough test on any new treestand you're considering. Try it. Put it on your back. Check out the ease of carrying and weight. Is it quick, quiet and easy to put on the tree? If it's a climber does it climb quietly? How about stability, leveling, and comfort? Is it TMA Certified? Remember, your treestand is a necessity, not an accessory.


