

# Predator Pod Instruction Booklet - 2006

#### **READ ME FIRST!!!**

Please read carefully **BEFORE** using your new Predator Pod Stand.

Congratulations! You have purchased the finest commercially available pod stand on the market today. Summit Pod Stands are designed and built to provide years of trouble-free, successful hunting with a minimum of maintenance and care. It is certified to meet the requirements of the Treestand Manufacturers Association (TMA) Standards This booklet is provided to you to outline the recommended use, care and maintenance of your Summit Pod Stand.

### **Warnings and Precautions**

- YOU MUST FULLY READ, UNDERSTAND AND FOLLOW THESE INSTRUCTIONS!
- DO NOT USE THIS OR ANY OTHER STAND IF YOU HAVE BEEN USING DRUGS OR ALCOHOL OR ARE PHYSICALLY IMPAIRED IN ANY WAY!
- FOR YOUR SAFETY, DO NOT USE ANY TREESTAND DURING STORMS, WHEN TREES ARE WET OR ICY, OR ON TREES THAT ARE LEANING OR THAT APPEAR DEAD OR DISEASED!
- DO NOT USE ANY POD OR TREE STAND IF YOU HAVE NOT FOLLOWED THE MANUFACTURERS CARE AND MAINTENANCE GUIDELINES!
- DO NOT USE ANY POD OR TREE STAND UNLESS YOU ARE IN GOOD PHYSICAL SHAPE. THE ABILITY TO DO SEVERAL PUSH-UPS, CHIN-UPS, SIT-UPS, ETC. IS REQUIRED FOR YOUR SAFETY!

#### Warning

Before each use of your Summit Predator POD, ALWAYS inspect the stand for any structural damage, cracks, cable wear or abrasion that may have occurred in transporting your stand. DO NOT USE IF <u>ANY</u> DAMAGE IS FOUND! DO NOT leave your stand outdoors when it is not being used. <u>Any tubing that is allowed to fill with</u> rainwater and freeze WILL rupture or burst. DO NOT use your Stand if this happens.

#### Section 1. Assembling Your Predator Pod Stand.

#### Part 1. Base Plate Assembly.

**Step 1.** Orient the base plate and one leg as shown in **Figure 1**.

**NOTE** the correct orientation of the leg. The pre-punched hole is to the inside - as is the welded on bracket located lower on the leg.

**Step 2.** Slide the leg into the Base Plate and line up the holes. Secure with one 5/16" (1 3/4" long) bolt and 5/16" lock nut. **NOTE:** These are the **ONLY** 5/16" bolts used for assembly. All remaining bolts are 1/4" thread size.

**Step 3.** Repeat two more times as shown in **Figure 2**. Use one 1 3/4" bolt per leg. Steps on the other legs must face out like the first leg.

Step 4. Position the Seat Swivel as shown in Figure 3.

NOTE - Leave bolts/nuts hand tight until all are started.

**Step 5.** Bolt the Seat Swivel to the Base Plate as shown in Figure 4. The correct order should be: 1" bolt / Washer / Swivel Plate / 1/4" Nylon Spacer / Base Plate / Lock Nut (See **Figure 4**).

**Step 6.** Repeat 3 more times with three more 1" bolts, washers, spacers and lock nuts as shown in **Figure 5**.

Step 7. Wrench tighten all bolts.

#### Part 2. Seat Base Assembly.

Step 1. Orient the Seat Base as shown in Figure 6.

**NOTE** - Leave bolts/nuts hand tight until all are started.

**Step 2.** Bolt the Seat Base to the Seat Swivel as shown in **Figure 7**. the correct order should be: 3/4" bolt / Seat Base / 1/4" Nylon Spacer / Seat Swivel / Washer / Lock Nut.

**Step 3.** Repeat 3 more times with three more 3/4" bolts, washers, spacers and lock nuts as shown in **Figure 8**.

Step 4. Wrench tighten all bolts.

**Step 5.** Position Seat Back as shown in **Figure 9**. Insert four Long Shank bushings into the pre-punched holes on the Seat Back. Insert two short shank bushings into the **outside** of the bracket on the Seat Base. (See **Figure 9**)

**Step 6.** Secure using two 1 3/4" bolts with lock nuts.

**Step 7.** Position the Gun Rest as shown in **Figure 10**. Slide the Gun Rest into the bracket and line up the holes. Secure with one 1 3/4" bolt and lock nut. Do not overtighten as this connection is designed to pivot.


#### Part 3. Center Support Assembly.


**Step 1.** Position the Predator Pod as shown in **Figure 11**. Insert three short shank bushings to the inside of the welded on L-Bracket as shown in **Figure 11**.


**Step 2.** Position the Center Support Assembly as shown in Figure 12. The Support Assembly will bolt to the inside of the L-Brackets and sit against the short shank bushings. Secure each joint with one 3/4" bolt and lock nut. Do not overtighten as this joint is designed to pivot.


#### Part 4. Seat and Back Rest pad.


**Step 1.** Attach the 36" comfort pad to the Back Rest Support as shown in **Figure 13**. The cable ties for attaching the pads are "inline" cable ties: Note the correct and incorrect ways of attaching. To attach - pull the cable ties snug, cut off the excess, and rotate the clasp to the underside of the pad.






























**Step 2.** Lay the foam seat pad down on the Seat Base. Snap the webbing straps around the backrest tube as shown in **Figure 14**.

#### Section 2. Use of the Predator Pod.

WARNING: THE PREDATOR POD IS DESIGNED TO WORK ON LEVEL GROUND ONLY. MAKE SURE THAT THE LOCATION YOU CHOOSE IS FREE OF ROCKS OR OTHER DEBRIS.

- **Step 1.** Fold all the legs out until all three are an equal distance apart. They should be spread out as much as possible to provide the most stable base. The Center Support should be almost horizontal as shown in **Figure 15**.
- **Step 2.** Tie your gun or bow to a pull-up rope and then tie the other end to your belt or around the top of the stand where you can reach it.
- **Step 3.** Carefully climb up the steps. Once you reach the seat, swing one of your legs over and around the gun rest. Make sure your boots are both firmly in place on two of the top steps. Carefully sit down.
- **Step 4.** Pull the gun rest up towards you, then push it down into the bracket to lock it. Bow hunters might want to skip this step.
- Step 5. Pull up your gun or bow and begin hunting.





#### Section 3. Maintenance and Care of Your Treestand.

Because of the quality construction techniques used in manufacturing, your Summit Treestand is very durable under normal hunting conditions. However, since all hunting equipment that is exposed to the elements requires some maintenance and care, the following guidelines for caring for your treestand should be used. **DO NOT** leave your treestand outdoors when it is not being used. **Any tubing that is allowed to fill with rainwater and freeze WILL rupture or burst. DO NOT use your treestand if this happens.** If your treestand is exposed to the elements, it will be necessary to cover the seat to prevent rain and moisture from saturating the material. This will extend the life of the seat material as well as make it more comfortable the next time it is used.

The powder coat finish that is applied at the factory is very durable and should need touch ups only in areas of heavy wear or accidental impact.

Should you damage any part of your Summit Treestand, contact your nearest authorized Summit dealer or the factory to obtain the proper corrective action procedure and/or replacement parts for the treestand. Unauthorized repairs, modifications, or alterations will void the warranty and could degrade the integrity of the treestand. You must perform periodic inspections of the treestand for damage. WARNING: DO NOT use the treestand if ANY obvious or suspected damage is observed.

CAUTION: Look for nicks, gouges, cuts, cracks, bends, corrosion or similar damage that can be the result of improper user or accidental damage. For instance, this could occur if someone else used the treestand without knowledge of its proper use, or if the treestand were dropped, hit by a motor vehicle or subject to corrosive conditions, etc. Summit Treestands have the highest structural integrity by design, material selection and manufacturing techniques, but as its owner, only your continued care will assure trouble free performance. When the above-mentioned guidelines are followed, your Summit Treestand will provide years of successful hunting.
