### **Seat Instructions**

# For PNs 85020, 85058-85060, 85071, 85075

Buckle Instructions - PN 85020, 85058-85060 - Three bar slide setup.

- **Step 1.** Position the 3 bar slide on the webbing as shown in **Figure 1**.
- Step 2. Bring the loose webbing end over the frame as shown in Figure 2.
- **Step 3.** Thread the webbing back through the 3 bar slide as shown in **Figure**
- 3. The finished webbing should look like Figure 4.

**Step 4.** Roll the very end of the webbing up and attach two hog rings as shown in **Figure 5**. Use pliers to clamp the rings on. Your completed straps should look like **Figure 6**.

#### Repeat for the other three straps.

Loosen the straps and slide the buckles to adjust the height.


## Buckle Instructions - PN 85071, 85075 - Two piece metal buckle.

- **Step 1.** Position the webbing over the frame as shown in **Figure 7**.
- **Step 2.** Turn the 3 bar slide to the side and push it through the large sewn on D shaped ring as shown in **Figure 8**.
- Step 3. The 3 bar slide should look like Figure 9.
- Step 4. Your finished strap should look like Figure 10.

#### Repeat for the other three straps.

Slide the 3 bar slide on the webbing to adjust the height.



















Inflation Instructions: PN 85020 or other Air Seat

The Summit Air Seat has two air valves, one in the base pad and one in the backrest as shown in **Figure 11** (PN 85019 will only have one valve in the base pad).

## NOTE: THE VALVES <u>DO NOT</u> HAVE A SCREW ON CAP - <u>NO CAP IS NEEDED!</u>

To inflate, position the valve through the cutout in the seat fabric. Pull up/out on the valve (See Figure 12). Blow the seat up to the desired level. PUSH THE VALVE BACK IN TO CLOSE (See Figure 13).
