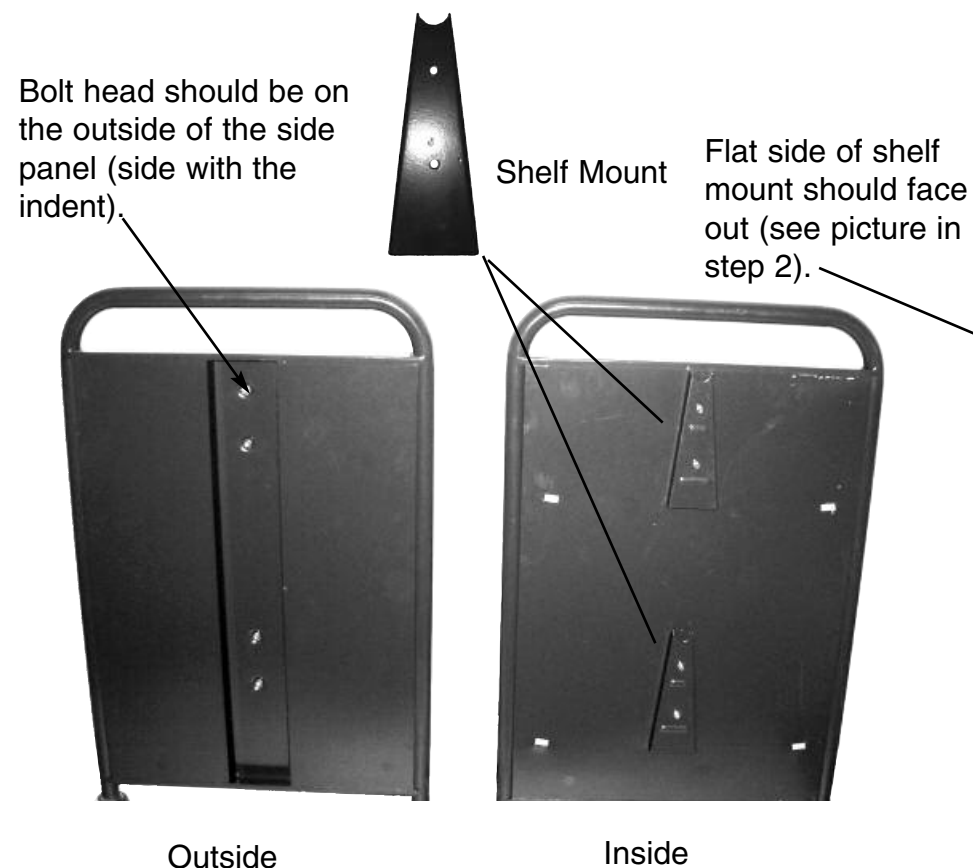

### Parts List

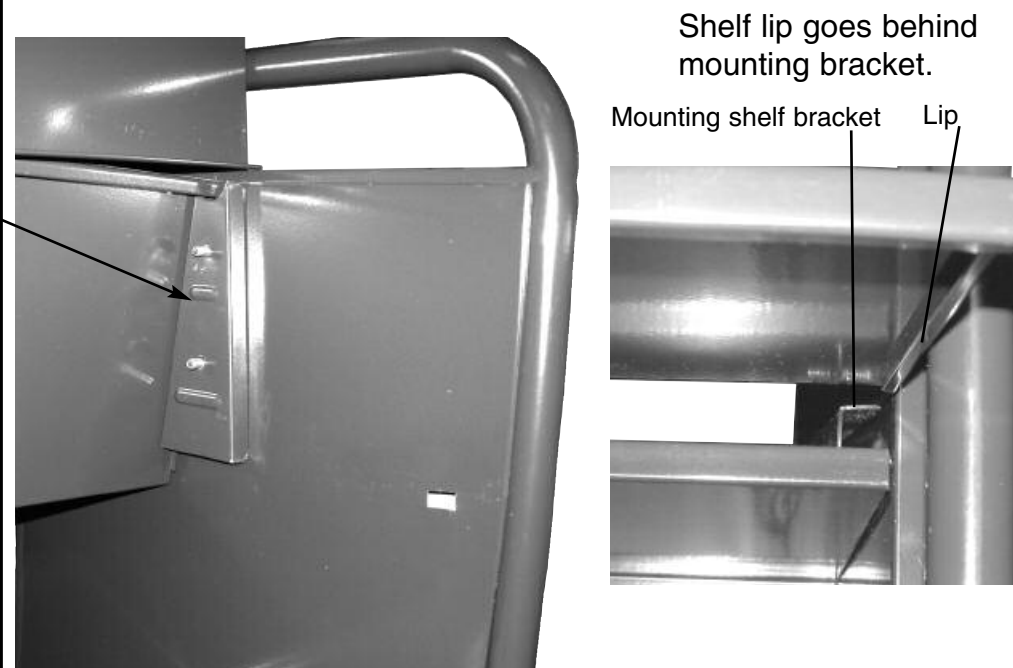
- All book trucks include:
- 2 - Side panels
  - 4 - Casters (two with brake)
- 1 - Plastic clip per side of slanted shelf
- Parts for each flat shelf:
- 4 - Screws
  - 2 - Shelf supports
  - 1 - Shelf
- Parts for each slanted shelf:
- 2 - Mounting Shelf brackets
  - 2 - Shelves
  - 2 - Shelf uprights
  - 4 - Screws

**1** Mount shelf brackets to the inside of side panels using included screws as shown, **Do Not Fully Tighten**.

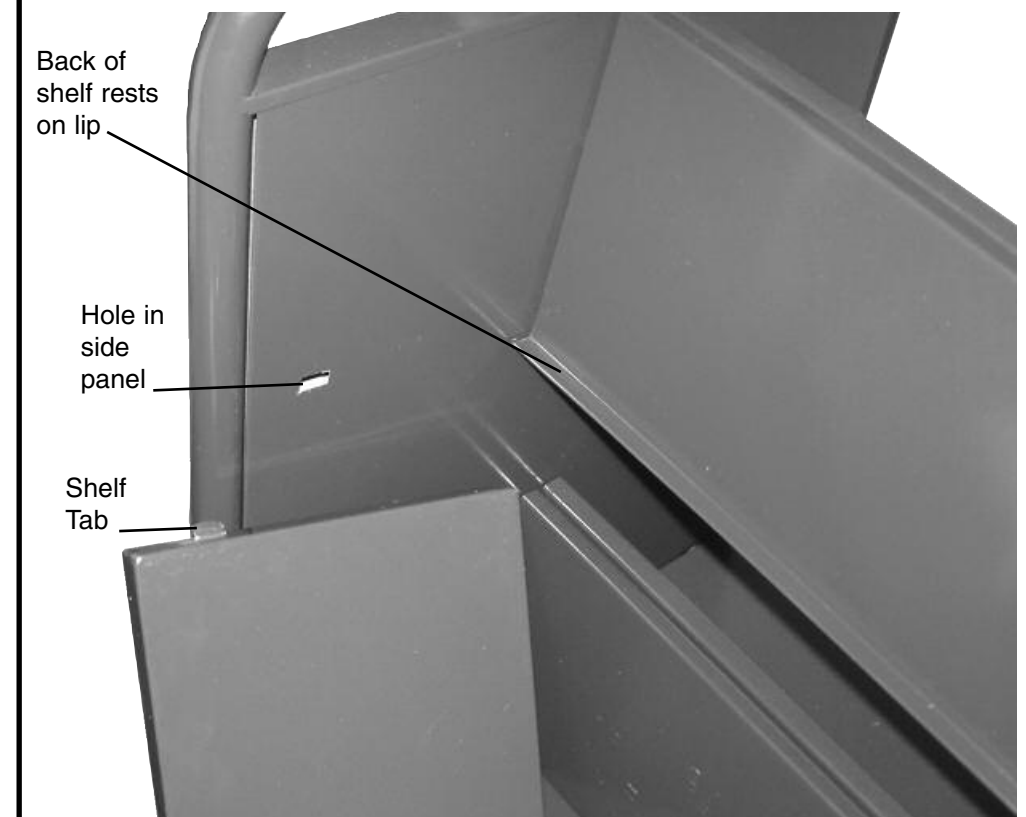


**Note: Assemble shelves starting with the bottom shelf up to the top shelf.**

**2** Slide shelf uprights (back of shelves) onto the shelf mounts. The side of the shelf upright has a lip that should be between the shelf mount and side panel. Top of shelf upright hangs on shelf mount.



**3** Insert tab on side of shelf bottom into hole on side panel and rest back of shelf on bottom lip of shelf upright. Now fully tighten screws for all shelf mounts.



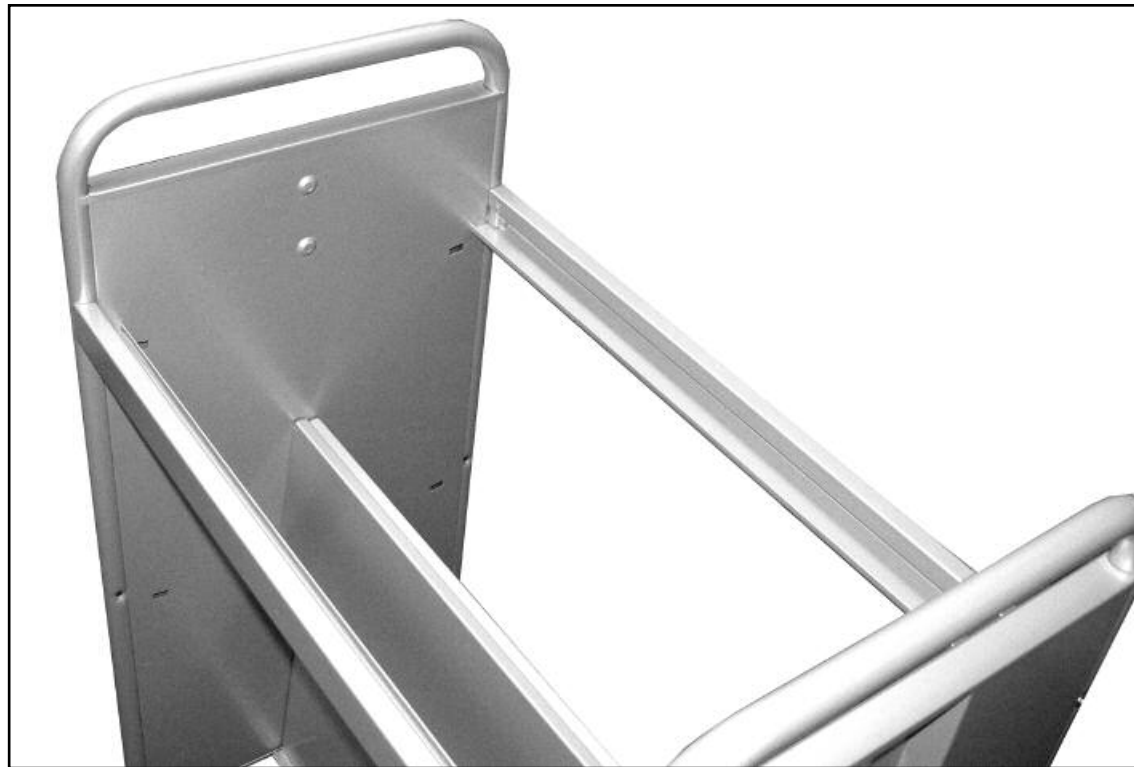
**4** From under side of each shelf, use plastic clip on inside edge of each slanted shelf to secure back of shelf to lip on shelf upright.



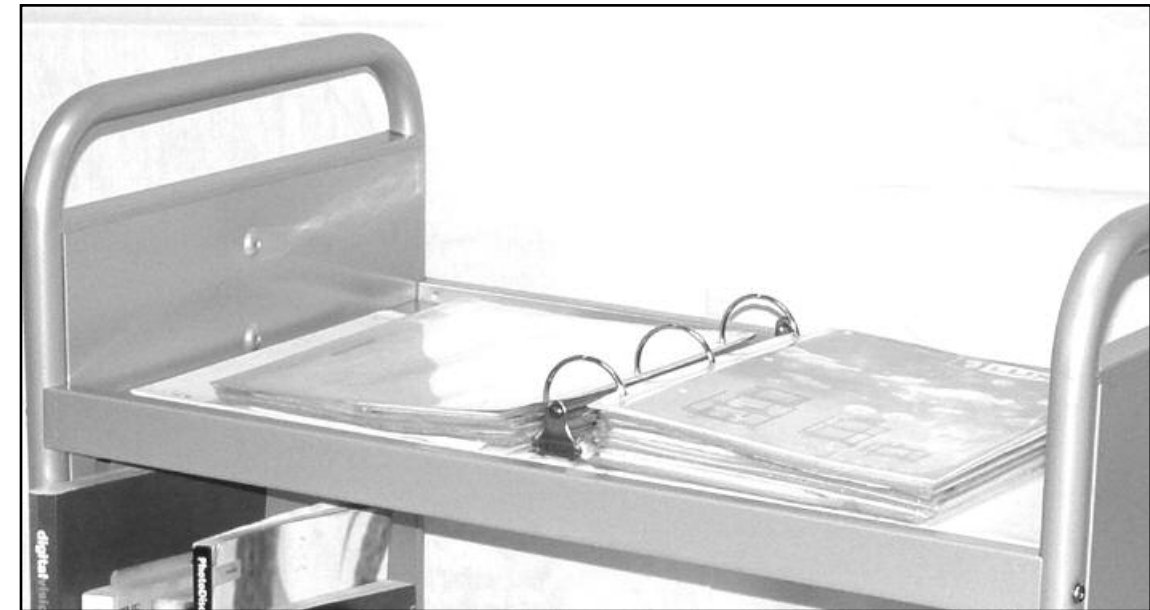
**5** Turn cart upside-down and insert casters. Locking casters should be on the same end or same side per your preference.



**Flat shelf instructions on back.** →



- 1** Attach flat shelf supports as shown with screw through each end of side panel.



- 2** Place shelf in between shelf supports and press into place.

Apply accent strip starting at the bottom and work up to the top making sure to apply flush to the surface and work out any air bubbles as you go.
